- Exact dates and times will be advised to successful applicants.
- Cinderella will be staging Schools Performances and all dancers will need to have a relevant licence from their local authority to enable them to be absent from school for those performances. The production company will arrange this via CD Licensing who will contact successful performers directly using the information provided on this application.
- You will also need to be able to commit to the full run and rehearsal period.
- Ensemble members will be unpaid and will be expected to provide their own leotard, shoes and tights.
- Notification of exact requirements will be given at the start of rehearsals.
